We have an exciting role in our Business Development department as a Private Slaughter Co-ordinator, who will lead QMS' work on supporting farmers access private slaughter facilities across Scotland.

As a Private Slaughter Co-ordinator at QMS, no two working days will be the same. One day you could be visiting farmers to understand their requirements, the next you could be speaking to processors or independent butchers. You will be supported by our Business Development department, and other members of the wider QMS team.

This role is three days per week (21 hours), on a 9 month fixed term contract. However, we are focused on getting the right candidate, so flexible working patterns could be considered. Our office is based in the outskirts of Edinburgh, however the role will be field based with some working from home or in our office as required.
